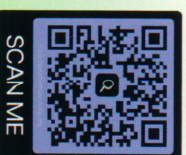
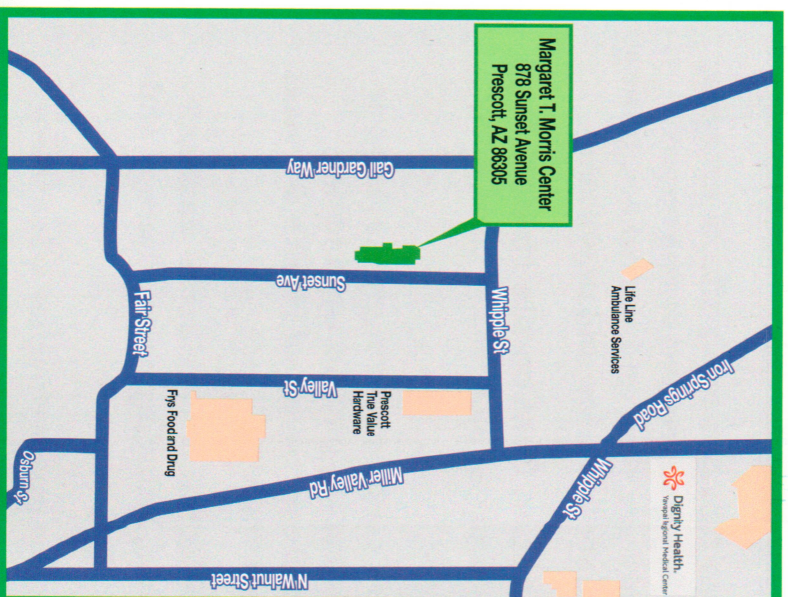

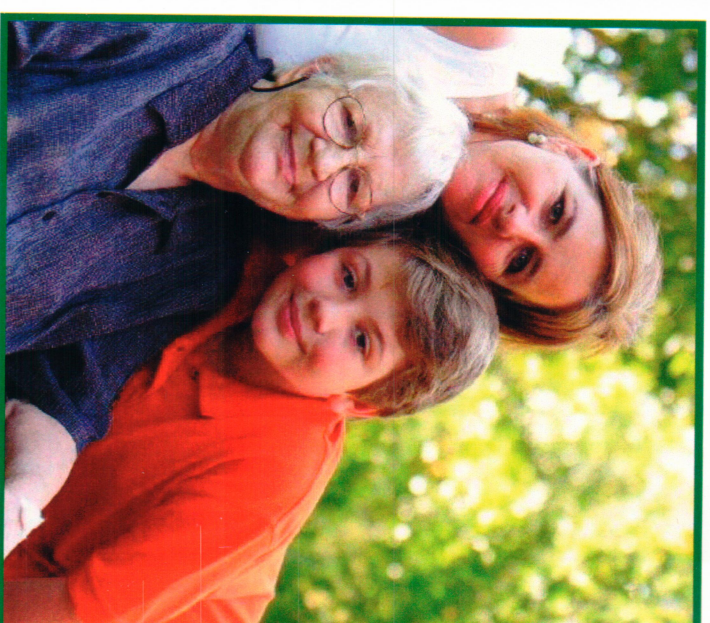
Our residents and families have an exceptional experience through our:

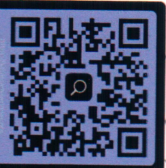

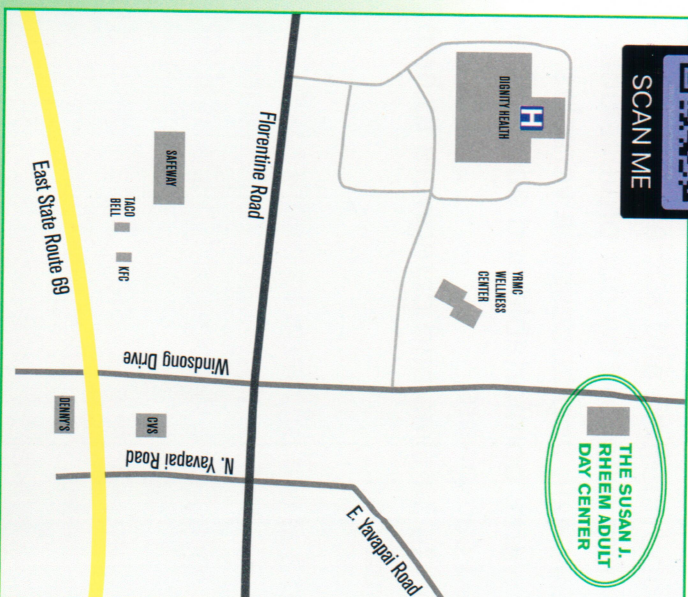
